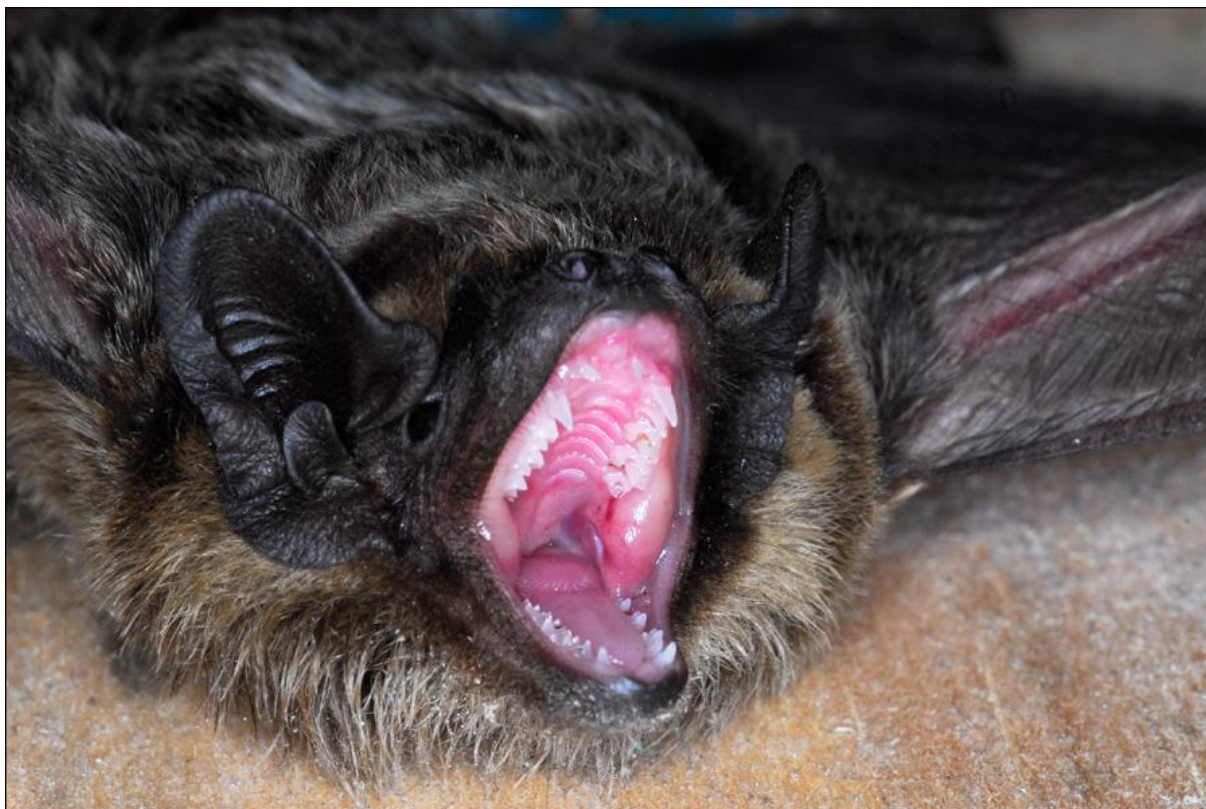


LIST OF BATS, SEEN IN THE FAROE ISLANDS UNTIL 31.12.2010



Until now 90 bats are found or seen in the Faroe Islands. The latest 42 came in the invasion in the autumn of 2010 and they were observed all over Faroe Islands.

We have managed to identify some of the species, and they are as follows:

1 Dvørgflogmús - Dværgflagermus - <i>Pipistrellus pipistrellus</i> - Common Pipistrellus Bat
1 Leislerflogmús - Leislers flagermus - <i>Nyctalus leisleri</i> - Leisler's Bat
2 Hýggiflogmýs - Skimmelflagermus - <i>Vespertilio murinus</i> - Parti-coloured Bat
1 Niðuflogmús - Sydflagermus - <i>Eptesicus serotinus</i> - Serotine Bat (imported with building materials)
12 Trøllflogmýs - Troldflagermus - <i>Pipistrellus nathusii</i> - Nathusius's Pipistrelle Bat
1 ? - Nordflagermus - <i>Eptesicius nilsonii</i> - Northern Bat
72 unidentified bats
